



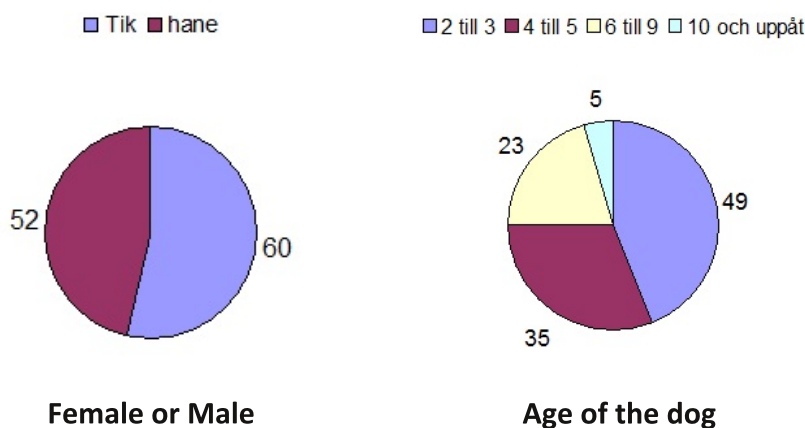
Results of the **Health Survey** for barbets in Sweden

- open for dogs 2 years or older -
The summary was made in spring 2016

There are approximately 220 barbets over 2 years at this time, and approximately 50% have responded to the survey. All but five charts below refer to the 100+ respondents in the survey. Five charts refer to 220+ barbets, either because there is available statistics in the SKK national database for all barbets, or because a lot of information is available on the particular issue, beside the survey.

The following questions from the questionnaire are not illustrated in the charts below.

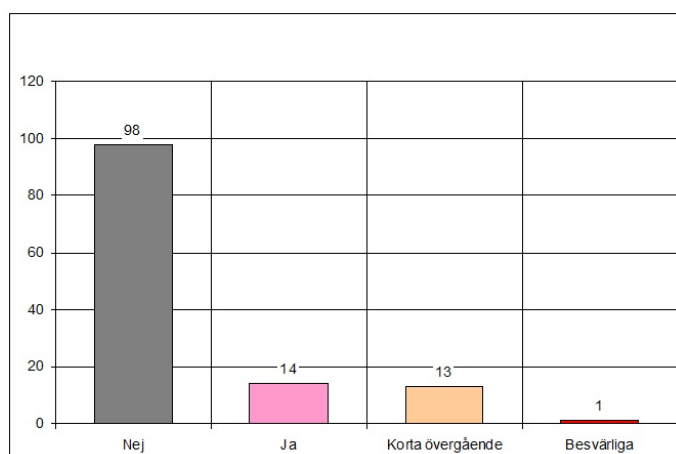
5: Liver - nothing significant is reported. / 9: Parasitic Diseases - a few kennel cough and two Lyme disease. / 13: Teeth - nothing significant reported / 18: Joint and skeletal disorders in general - "Yes, but not anymore" answered by a few. / 22-23: Deceased dog, and how it died - nothing significant reported.



- About as many females as males are represented in the survey.

- It's only a small proportion of older dogs represented in the survey.

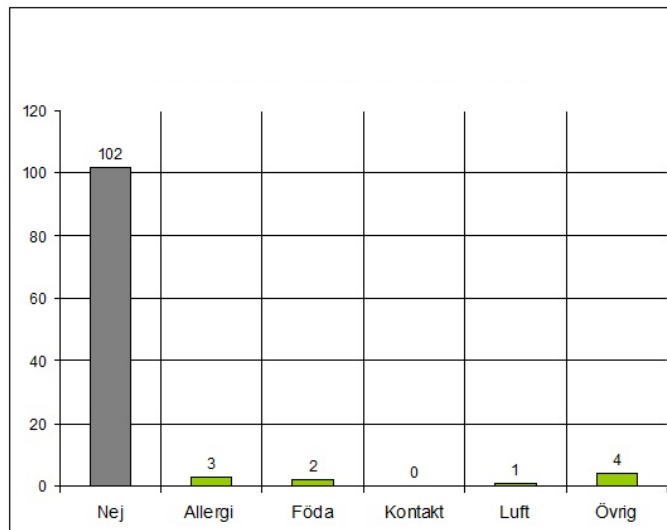


Skin Problems

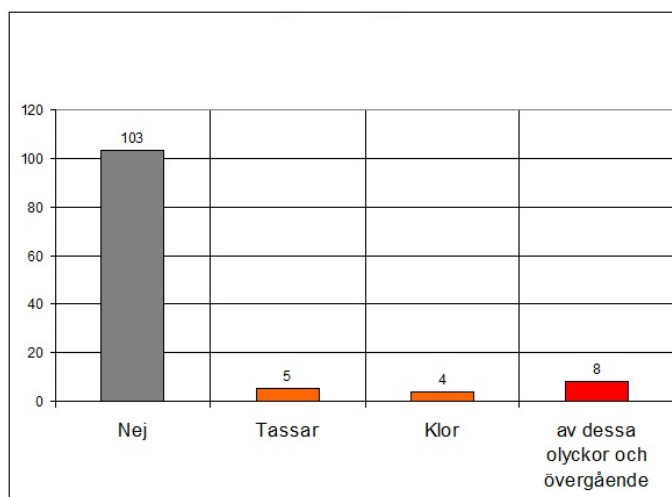

Paws and Claws

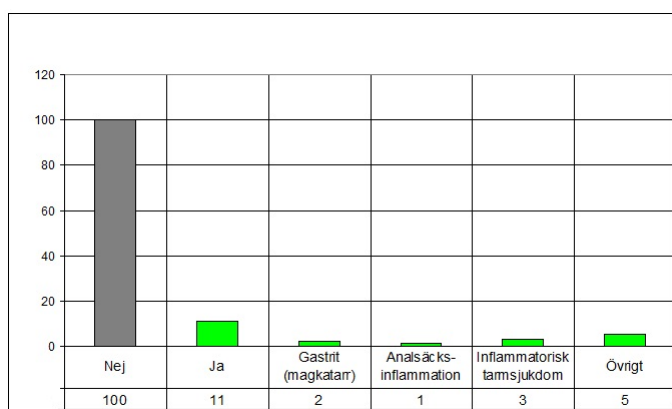
Does the dog have, or has it had problems with paws or claws?

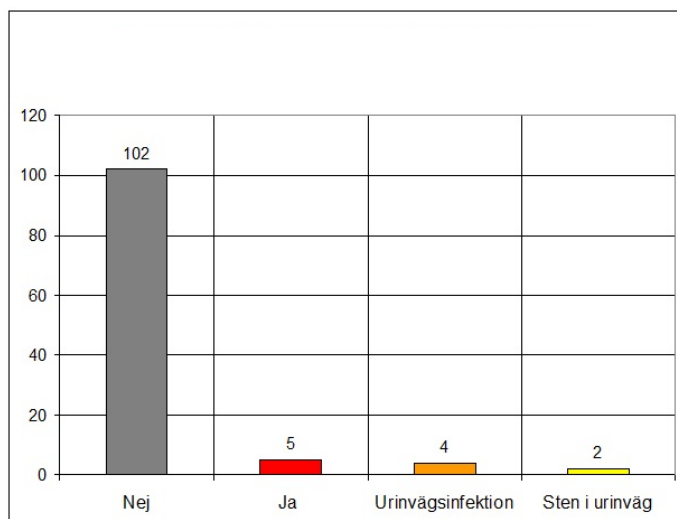

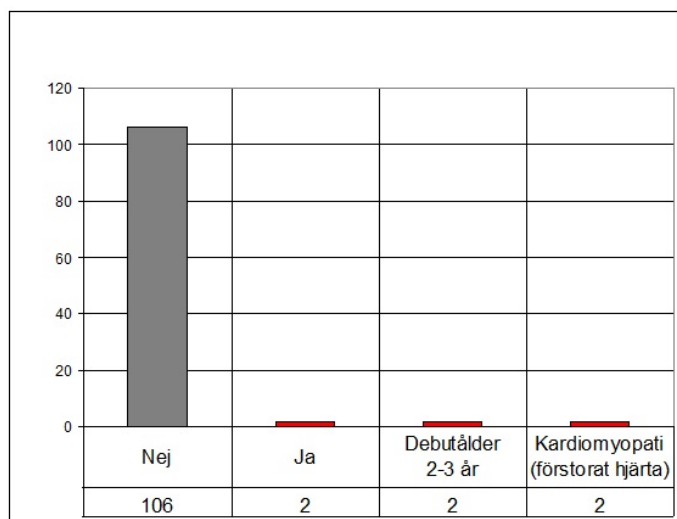

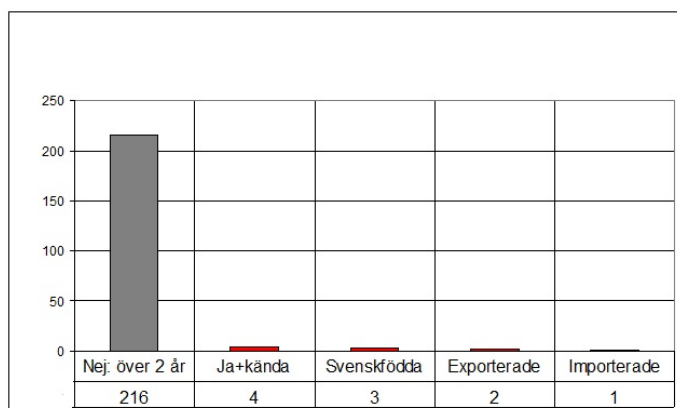

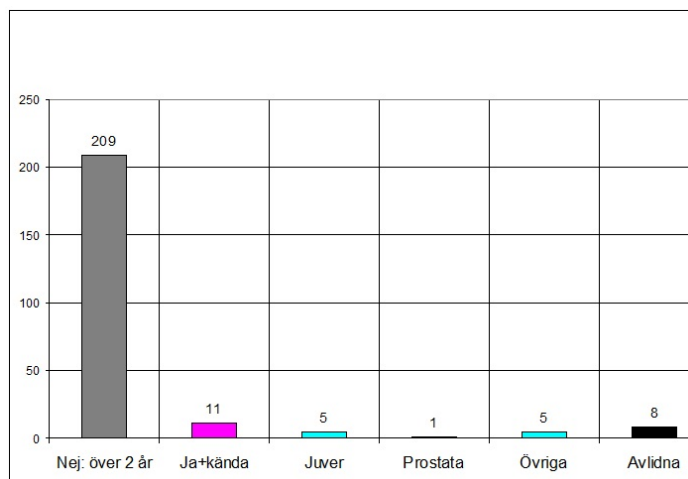

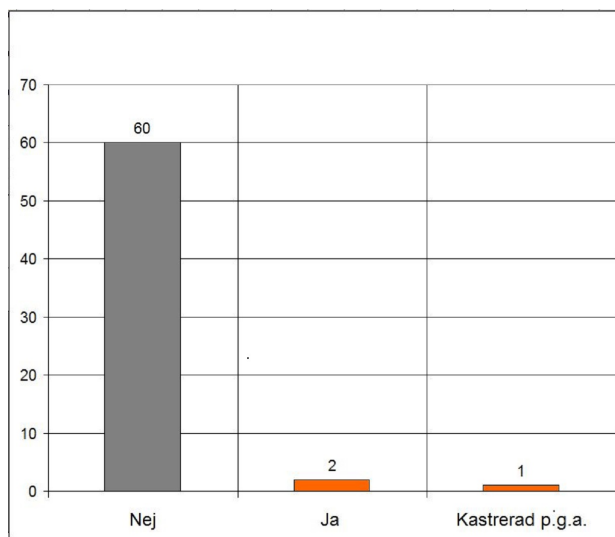

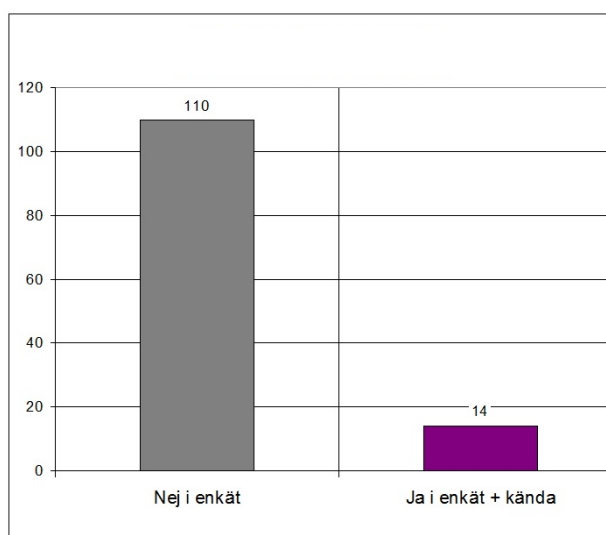

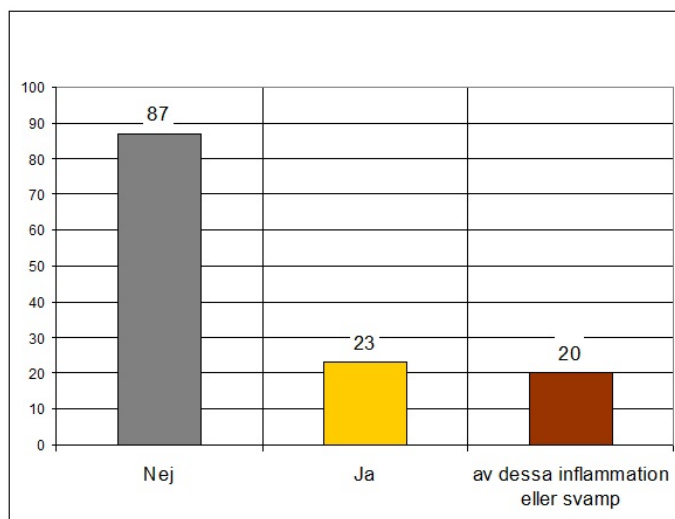

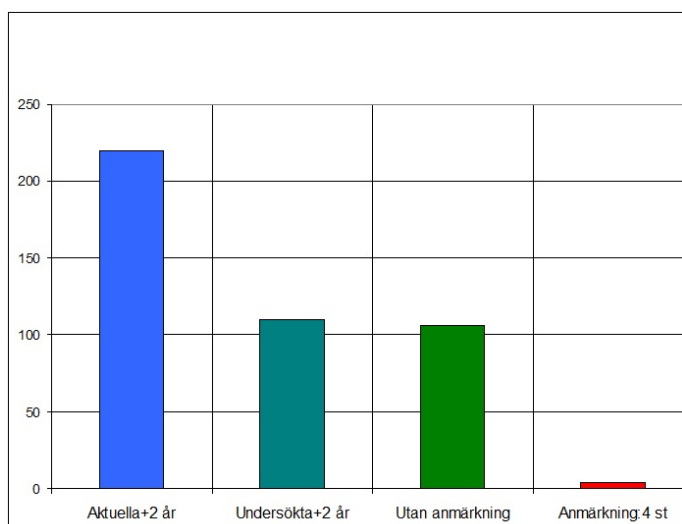

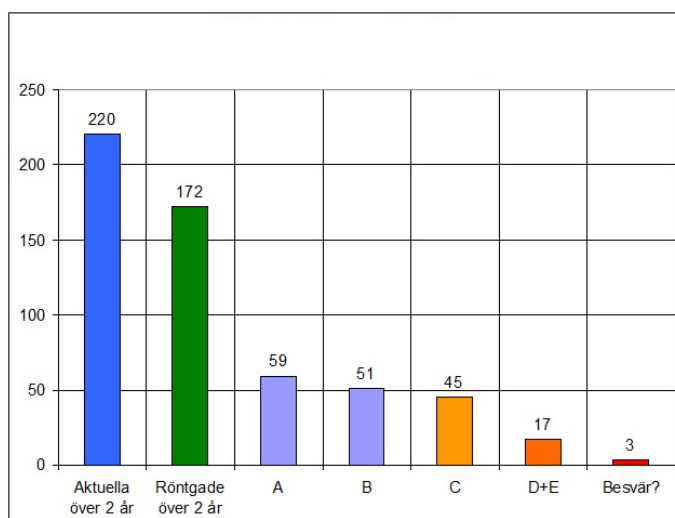

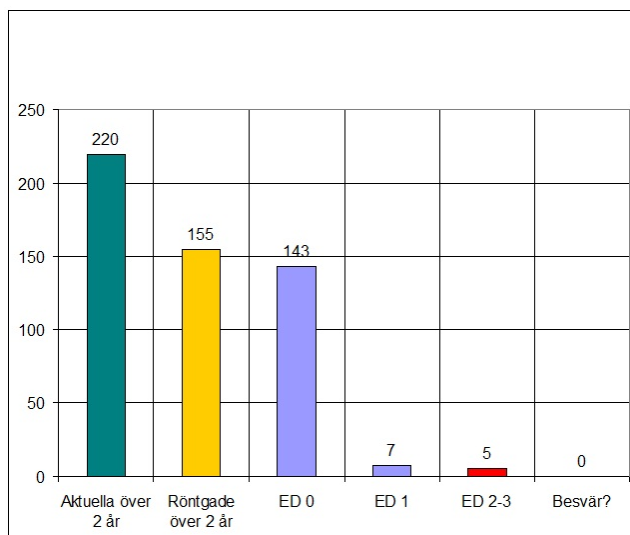


X-ray of the hips

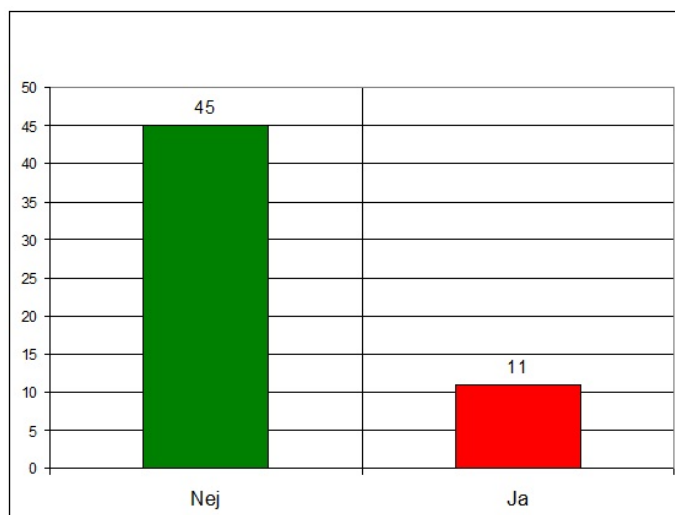

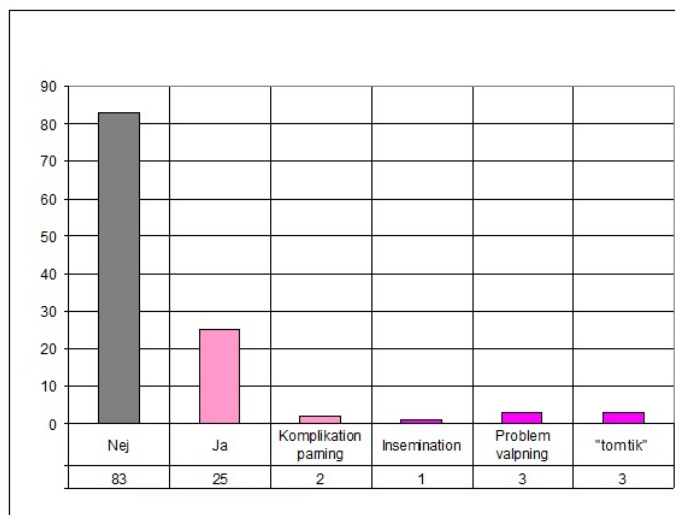
